Campus Scale

Population

- ~ 50,000 students
 - 7500+ residents
- 8,100 staff
- 4,350 faculty



Land & Building Stock

- 2000 acre main campus
- 388 acres of conservation land
- 887 Main Campus Buildings
- 1,932 Buildings Total in FL

Total energy usage 2010-2011: 440.2 million kWh

Total Waste per year: ~16,000 tons!

 - Student Compost Cooperative












Waste Audit



- ~16,000 Tons/year, 35% diversion
- Big Opportunities for Reduction:

Paper – 14.26% not being recycled

Organics- 15.28% of waste stream

You may be surprised:Cans and Bottles are only0.33% of total waste stream!





Carbon Neutral by 2025

Climate Action Plan: "reduce, renew, then offset... in ways that are local, tangible, and reliable."

What's Happening Now?

- Contracts
- Bin Audits
 - Indoor and outdoor bins across campus
- Dining
 - Trayless dining halls, Reusable to-go program = 60,000 lbs of food waste, 470,000 gallons of water saved
 - Styrofoam Free
 - Organics options
- Labs: Corning Pipet box recycling, cooler pack take-back program
- Grounds: All yard waste is composted
- Online "swap meet" and "chem swap" websites
 - Auctions and donations of campus surplus goods.





It's Your Goal!


- We all generate waste and we all have the power to make a change

GHG Inventory



- Energy: \$43 million = \$3.6 million/month
- FY 2004/2005 is the baseline year for our reduction targets.
- Electricity is the leading contributor to UF's GHG emissions (69%)
- Building retrofits and behavior change campaigns

Buildings and Grounds

- LEED Gold standard for all new buildings
 - First LEED platinum building in the state
 - LEED-EB portfolio in progress
 - Currently 21 LEED-NC buildings



- Low-impact and native plant landscaping
- 2 sites with student garden plots
- 31 campus conservation areas
- Over 95% of UF's irrigation water is reclaimed at wastewater treatment plant







Food and Dining

- Internal Sustainability Manager and Green Teams
- 26% of food is organic or locally sourced

 - "Meatless Mondays"
- Reusable to-go container program
- Styrofoam Free!



- Get involved in campus/community politics








