Snapshot: Scale




- Energy: \$43 million = \$3.6 million/month



Municipal Solid Waste (MSW): (48.25%, 8,740 tons annually)

Construction & Demolition Debris: (12.91%, 2,339 tons annually)

Recyclable Material: (36.50%, 6,613 tons annually)

Medical Waste: (1.81%, 328 tons annually)

Hazardous Waste: (0.52%, 95 tons annually).

Game Day Recycling



- Volunteer outreach to "tailgators" and within the stadium
- 86,840 lbs of recycling this year!
- Stadium concessions converting to compostable and recyclable options
- Gator Green Team FB



Campus Initiatives



- Indoor and outdoor recycling bins across campus
- Dining: Trayless dining halls, Reusable to-go program
 - 60,000 lbs of food waste, 470,000 gallons of water saved
- Labs: Corning Pipet box recycling, cooler pack take-back program
- Grounds: All yard waste is composted
- Online "swap meet" and "chem swap" websites
 - Auctions and donations of campus surplus goods.



Reduce

- Widen your print margins and store documents electronically
- Buy in bulk to reduce packaging waste
- Store food in reusable containers
- Asked to be removed from mailing lists



Reuse

- Take reusable bags to the store
- Bring a reusable bottle or mug with you.
 Gator Dining offers discounts on coffee when you BYO
- Use scrap paper for notes
- Donate gently used clothing, books, school supplies, etc... and shop second-hand



Recycle- rinse and remove caps/lids:

- #1-7 plastics (unless they are brittle)
- Metal cans (including aerosal cans)
- Glass bottles and jars
- Paper, junkmail, newspaper, phonebooks, cardboard, pasteboard...
 - Keep dry and free from food waste



Recycle-

- Egg cartons/foam trays/plastic bags → Publix
- Electronic/Hazardous Waste
 - Campus Property: Asset Management & EHS
 - Available through Housing for residents
 - Annual collection day... in April

REthink



- Be conscious of your waste keep track of everything you throw away for a day, a week...
- Support companies using recycled and/or sustainably sourced materials in their products
- Garden on campus and compost your food waste
- Think of energy waste turn off lights, unplug electronics when done to reduce phantom energy load
